- Ability to identify trends in unsafe practices by crafts and make corrective recommendations to appropriate supervisors.
- Ability to investigate accidents, injuries, fires and other incidents and produce computer generated reports.

- Participate in supervisory and safety training.
- Ability to effectively communicate with all employees orally and in written format.
- Ability to respond to emergencies.
